Live Daily Interaction

Per the new California bill put out by our governor, students must have the opportunity for live interaction with their teacher and peers **daily**.

Here is some ways that can be done:

- Zoom sessions- either whole or small group
- Telephone calls
- Progress monitoring
- Feedback on work



Attendance

Can't attend a Zoom on a certain day? Don't panic.

Student attendance is tracked in several ways:

- Zoom meetings
- Completion of online assignments
- Evidence of completion of Edgenuity that day
- Communication with teacher by student and/or parent

If I do not hear from you or your student, and do not see evidence of online work, they WILL be marked absent.

I take attendance for each day, the FOLLOWING day. So you have until 11:59 PM each night to get credit for the day.

Zoom and Class Schedule



- We have two daily Zoom options
 - 9:00 am
 - 10:30 am
- There will be 1:1, and small group Zooms.
 - These will be scheduled well in advance.
 - 1:1 zooms will be offered during office hours, and parents will be asked to sign up for a time that works best for them.
 - These groups will NOT happen every week.
 - They will be designed to work on IEP goals and assessments.

IEPs- I am your child's case carrier.

- IEPs will be done virtually or via phone at this time.
 - They will be scheduled by the Orange Elementary school staff.
 - Student assessments will be done virtually. This will require 1:1 Zooms between your student and myself for progress monitoring.
- While I will be the one conducting your meeting, and doing the paperwork, I do NOT get control of the schedule. :(

More IEPs

- Your child will still receive any related services listed on their IEP
 - All related services such as speech, occupational therapy, etc., will be done virtually.
 - These services will be done by the the Orange Elementary therapists
- Service providers are working on schedules, *please be patient*. They are having to figure out schedules for all students whether virtual or traditional.
