HEALTH OFFICE

ILLNESS

Orange School has the services of a school nurse periodically. A part time health-clerk and the office staff oversee the health office the remainder of the week.

Students may be referred to the Health Office if they become ill during the day. Our basic policy is that if a student is not obviously ill or has no fever, we will ask that they try to remain in school. If a student is obviously ill, has a fever over 100 degrees or feels that they cannot remain at school, the parent will be called to pick them up. If the parent cannot be reached, a person listed on the emergency card will be called.

MEDICATION

If it is necessary for a student to receive medication during school hours (whether prescription or over the counter) the parent must bring the medicine to the school office in a pharmacy-dispensed container with the pharmacy label along with a medication form signed by the doctor and parent. **NO MEDICATION INCLUDING ASPIRIN, OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATION OR TYLENOL WILL BE DISPENSED WITHOUT THE SIGNED RELEASE.**

Parents may come to school and give medication to their child. A new medication form must be filled at the beginning of each school year
